5. The Resurrection is Jesus' rising to new life three days after his Death on the Cross.

April 2, 2023

3. Jesus said a prayer for each, and the bread and wine became his Body and Blood.
4. Before he died on the Cross, Jesus said: "It is finished."

April 9 & 16, 2023
