## September 22, 2024

1. Jesus tells his friends that he will be handed over, and he will be killed. Three days later, he will rise again.
2. As the new student at school, Victor felt a little uneasy.
3. Acts of service and selflessness make people great.
4. The word *assembly* refers to God's people gathered to offer praise and thanks to God and to act as a sign of Jesus Christ's presence in the world.
5. The first Christian community had 120 followers.

## September 29, 2024

1. Saint Oscar Romero spoke out because many people—including his own good friend, Father Rutilio Grande—were killed.
2. Saint Marianne ministered to people with Hansen's disease, or leprosy.
3. The first of two main parts of the Mass is the Liturgy of the Word.
4. The Lectionary is a book that contains the readings for Mass.
5. God's love is not reserved at all. It is for everyone.

## October 6, 2024

1. Matt changed his mind when he got to know his grandmother more.
2. Jesus said that a man leaves his parents and unites with a woman, and the two become one. They are no longer two, but one flesh.
3. Jesus became angry and told the disciples to let the children come to him. He also said that the Kingdom of God belongs to those who receive it like children.
4. The sign of the Sacrament of Matrimony is the exchanging of vows.
5. *Fidelity* means "being faithful to someone or something." A married couple pledges fidelity to each other.

## October 13, 2024

1. Lia picked as her speech subject her friend Grace, who was funny, nice and brave and also kind and strong.
2. Jesus says the rich man must keep God's Commandments, then sell everything he has, give the money to the poor, and follow Jesus.
3. The man goes away sad because he was very rich.

## October 20, 2024

1. Shrey and his service club collect towels for the young people who are homeless.

3. Jesus said he came to serve others and to give his life to save many.
4. To serve means to use our talents and energy to help others. This shows our love for others.
5. They selfishly imagine themselves sitting on either side of Jesus.

## October 27, 2024

1. Lily didn't realize that Amber and her mom were homeless and living out of their car.
2. Jesus says that Bartimaeus' faith has saved him.
3. Like Bartimaeus, we believe in Jesus without being able to see him. We can see things with our hearts that are not obvious to our eyes.
4. A miracle is a sign or wonder, such as a healing, that can only be attributed to God's power.
5. Many Gospel stories and sacraments include the use of dialogue, or talking back and forth.

## November 3, 2024

1. Carson and Jessica help Juan complete his home run walk around the bases because Juan hurt his knee.
2. The first is to love the Lord with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. The second is to love your neighbor as yourself.
3. The Sh'ma is a Jewish prayer that tells us Israel's most basic belief: the Lord our God is Lord alone.
4. The Commandments are laws from God. The Ten Commandments were the divine laws revealed to the People of Israel that describe our relationship and duties to God, others, and ourselves.
5. A creed states the most important beliefs of a religion.

## November 10, 2024

1. That prophet was Elijah.
2. Jesus said the widow gave more than all the others because she gave what she had to live on, while the others gave what they could spare without hurting.
3. Christians' love for God and for one another grow in our giving. Giving thanks helps us recognize new gifts God and others give us.
4. The first Christians celebrated Eucharist with a meal, just like the Last Supper.
5. The option for the poor is a theme of Catholic social teaching that tells us to first help the poorest people among us.
