November 13, 2022

1. Pope Francis hopes that no one feels like a stranger or outcast.
2. Nick decides to do something about the bullies because someone is getting hurt.
3. Jesus promises his followers wisdom in the face of violence and to be with us in the wars, disasters, and persecutions that will happen.
4. The Second Coming will be at the end of time when the Risen Jesus comes in glory to judge the living and the dead.
5. The first two steps in settling a conflict are stating the problem and proposing solutions.

November 20, 2022

1. Jesus rules with forgiveness and love.
2. When his parents divorce, Nico doesn't feel like doing anything and that would affect the team.
3. We benefit from Christ's sacrifice on the Cross because we are redeemed and have God's salvation.
4. Our salvation was accomplished through the Paschal Mystery—Jesus' suffering, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension.
5. Reconcile means to restore to friendship.

November 27, 2022

1. The second preparation that takes place during Advent is for the Second Coming of Jesus Christ.
2. The four martyrs of El Salvador are Jean Donovan, Sister Ita Ford, Sister Maura Clarke, and Sister Dorothy Kazel.
3. The Solemnity of Christ the King is the last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, while the First Sunday of Advent begins the year.
4. Jesus' earthly life teaches us how to be ready, to love each other as he loves us, to forgive one another, and to care for one another.
5. Each of the first readings during Advent come from the Book of the prophet Isaiah.

December 4, 2022

1. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception celebrates Mary's own conception in her mother's womb.
2. Jenna had to clean because her friend Claire was making a surprise visit.
3. John the Baptist tells the people to turn away from their sins because the Kingdom of Heaven is near.
4. We can be like John the Baptist during Advent by preparing the way for Jesus through our commitment to be disciples of Christ and to live as he wants us to.
5. A prophet makes God's will known by speaking, writing, or acting on God's behalf.

December 11, 2022

1. Cillian Jackson changed the success of the robotics team by showing them how helping others can be greater than winning a championship.
2. Jesus sends John a message that the deaf can hear, the blind see, the lame leap, the dead are raised, lepers are healed, and Jesus preaches to the poor.
3. Jesus describes John as the one who Scripture talks about, but also that John is greater than any man who ever lived. He also says the least in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than John.
4. Jesus is quoting Second Isaiah.
5. The virtue of hope enables us to remain focused on Heaven and to trust in God.

December 18, 2022

1. The voice speaking to Martin is Jesus.
2. The angel assures Joseph that Jesus was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit.
3. The Incarnation is the mystery of God becoming man.
4. *Las Posadas* is a tradition in which families go from house to house looking for a place where Mary and Joseph can stay.
5. The “festival of lights” is the Jewish celebration known as Hanukkah

December 25, 2022 & January 1, 2023

1. The angel of the Lord told the shepherds to not be afraid because a savior has been born, the Messiah and Lord.
2. Jesus is a Hebrew word that means “God saves”.
3. Like the shepherds, Jesus is born to a poor family.
4. We call Mary Theotokos because it is a Greek word meaning “Mother of God.”
5. Pulcheria was the sister of the Emperor Theodosius who lived in the fifth century. She is celebrated for her generosity, her leadership among women, and her work for the Church.

January 8 & 9, 2023

1. The birth of Jesus is first revealed to the shepherds in the fields.
2. Anna urges other young people to give a ministry like the Tijuana Ministry a try because they might find a new talent, experience something new, or connect with people you have little in common with.
3. During the Sacrament of Baptism, we are born to a new life with Jesus and unity with the Trinity.
4. The Holy Spirit’s appearance at Jesus’ baptism signifies that Jesus is the one, the Messiah.
5. Christians have compared Jesus and Abraham’s son Isaac because God did not spare Jesus from crucifixion, just as Abraham did not spare Isaac and God rescued Isaac, just as he raised Jesus from the dead.
