January 22, 2023

3. The Twelve Apostles were witnesses to Jesus' teachings, his healings, and his Paschal Mystery. They also shared what they saw and experienced.
4. All believers are called into the Kingdom of God. Everyone has a place, everyone is called to be part of the mission of Christ.
5. An epigrapher works to crack the codes of forgotten ancient alphabets and translate the texts.

January 29, 2023

1. Accept appropriate answers from this week's lesson, such as they were both refugees as babies.
2. When 3,000 young people went to pray at the Birmingham jail, the firefighters chose not to turn hoses on the praying people, and the police fell back.
3. *Beatitude* comes from a Latin word *beatus* that means "happy" or "blessed."
4. Accept any four of the eight Beatitudes taught by Jesus on the Sermon on the Mount.
5. The Gospel of Matthew, chapters five to seven, include the Sermon on the Mount teachings.

February 5, 2023

1. Griffin Burchard said he learned that it's important to know who we are and where we come from.
2. Accept reasonable answers, such as Jesus wanted us to be salt and light so people will see the good things that we do and give praise to God.
3. A rite includes words and actions used in celebrating the sacraments. They are based on Scripture and continue words and actions of Jesus.
4. Paul begins his letters by identifying himself and including a blessing.
5. Chloe Becker said she hoped her mural will be the start of conversation and education about racism.

February 12, 2023
